Side 1:

1. Find an article about Air Pollution in a **HDC** on the internet- my suggestion is to use ENN.com.
2. Write down the name, date, author, and website on the appropriate lines.
3. Read the article (obviously) and fill out as much of the remaining info as possible and IN AS MUCH DETAIL AS POSSIBLE.
4. For example, if the article is about air pollution caused by a coal fired power plant, you would circle industry/power plant under "causes of air pollution" and write a couple of **SENTENCES** describing it.
5. You should have ideas written down in "causes," "effects," "location," and "solutions" but you may not be able to fill out each subsection.

Side 2:

1. Same as side one, but find an article about Air Pollution in an **MDC/LDC**.
2. Use instructions from side 1.
